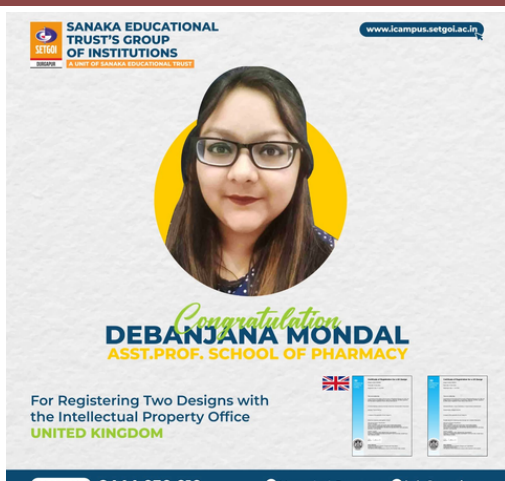
BREAKING BOUNDARIES IN INNOVATION: A REMARKABLE ACHIEVEMENT

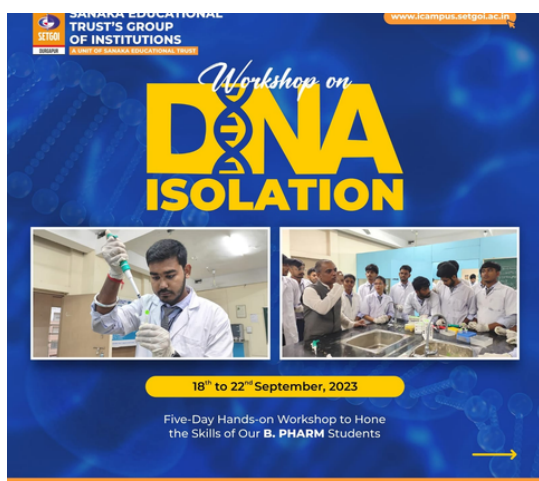
DNA ISOLATION WORKSHOP - 18TH TO 22ND SEPTEMBER, 2023
