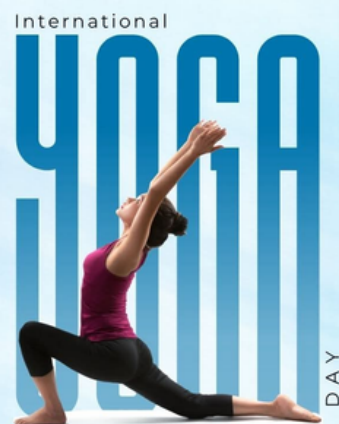
TREE PLANTATION - 05TH JUNE, 2025

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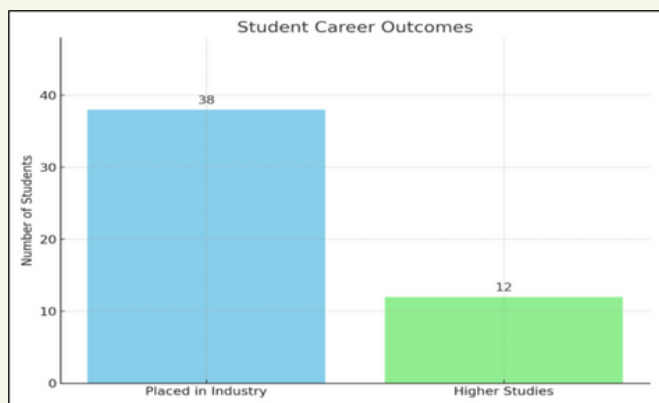

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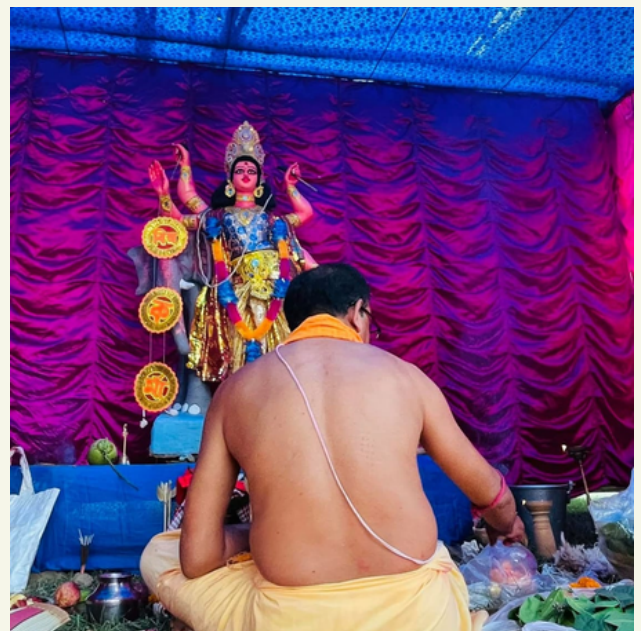


TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATION - 5TH SEPTEMBER 2024

BLOOD DONATION CAMP

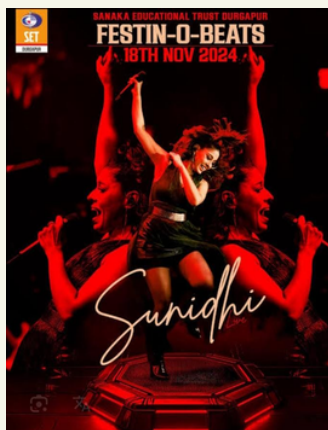
